In a nutshell

How to apply?

Applicants must hold a university degree based on at least 3.5 years of full-time studies (equivalent to 210 ECTS credits).

In addition, at least one year of professional experience in the area of human rights - or one year of professional experience in a different field, combined with practical experience in human rights work on a voluntary basis - is expected.

A certified command of English is required for admission.

Applications will be accepted between 3 February and 30 June. Decisions will be taken in March, May and July. To have your application reviewed in March or May, it has to reach us by the last working day of the previous month.
